

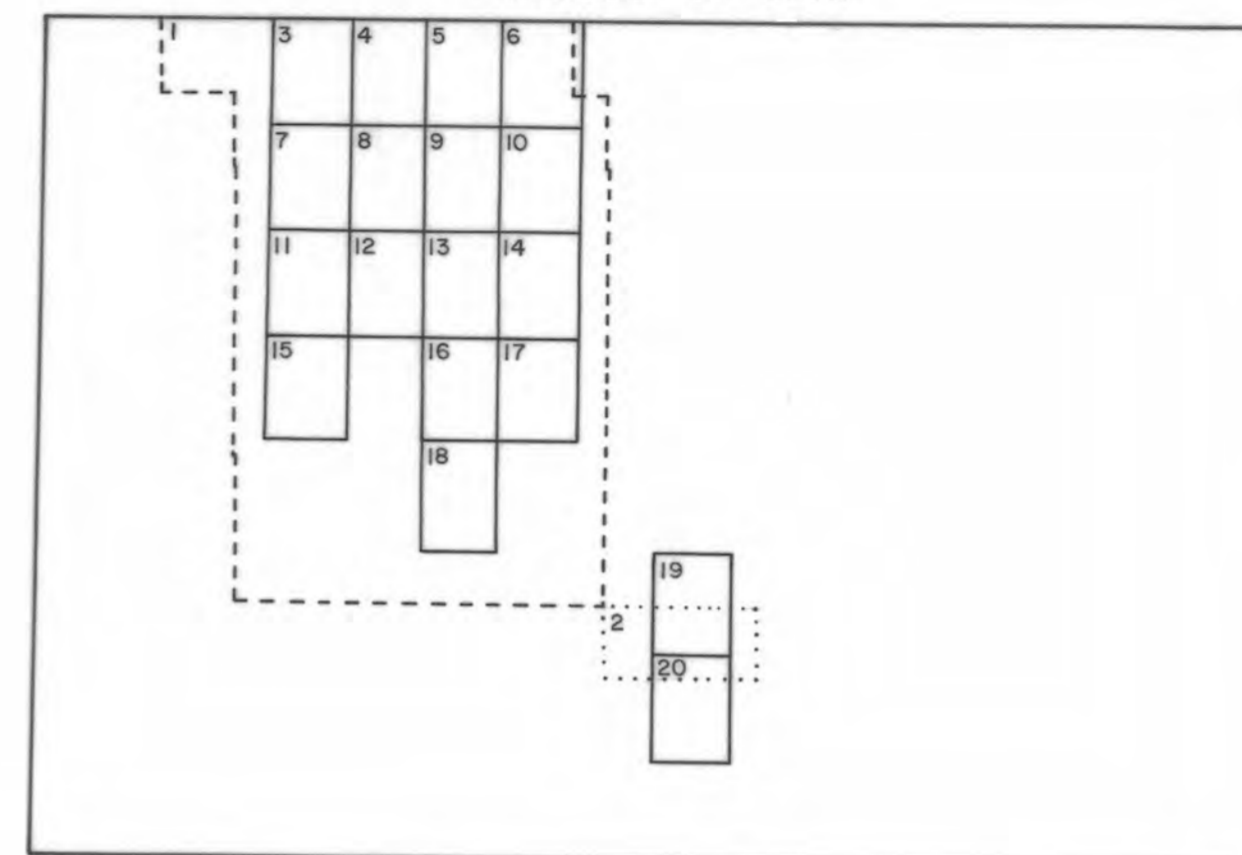
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EXPLANATION

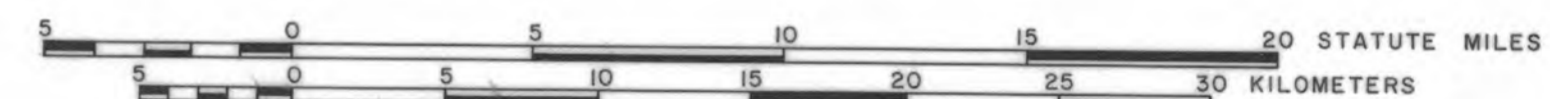


Baked or fused rock (also known as clinker or scoria). Rock baked or melted by naturally-ignited coal beds. Used as aggregate and ornamental stone.
