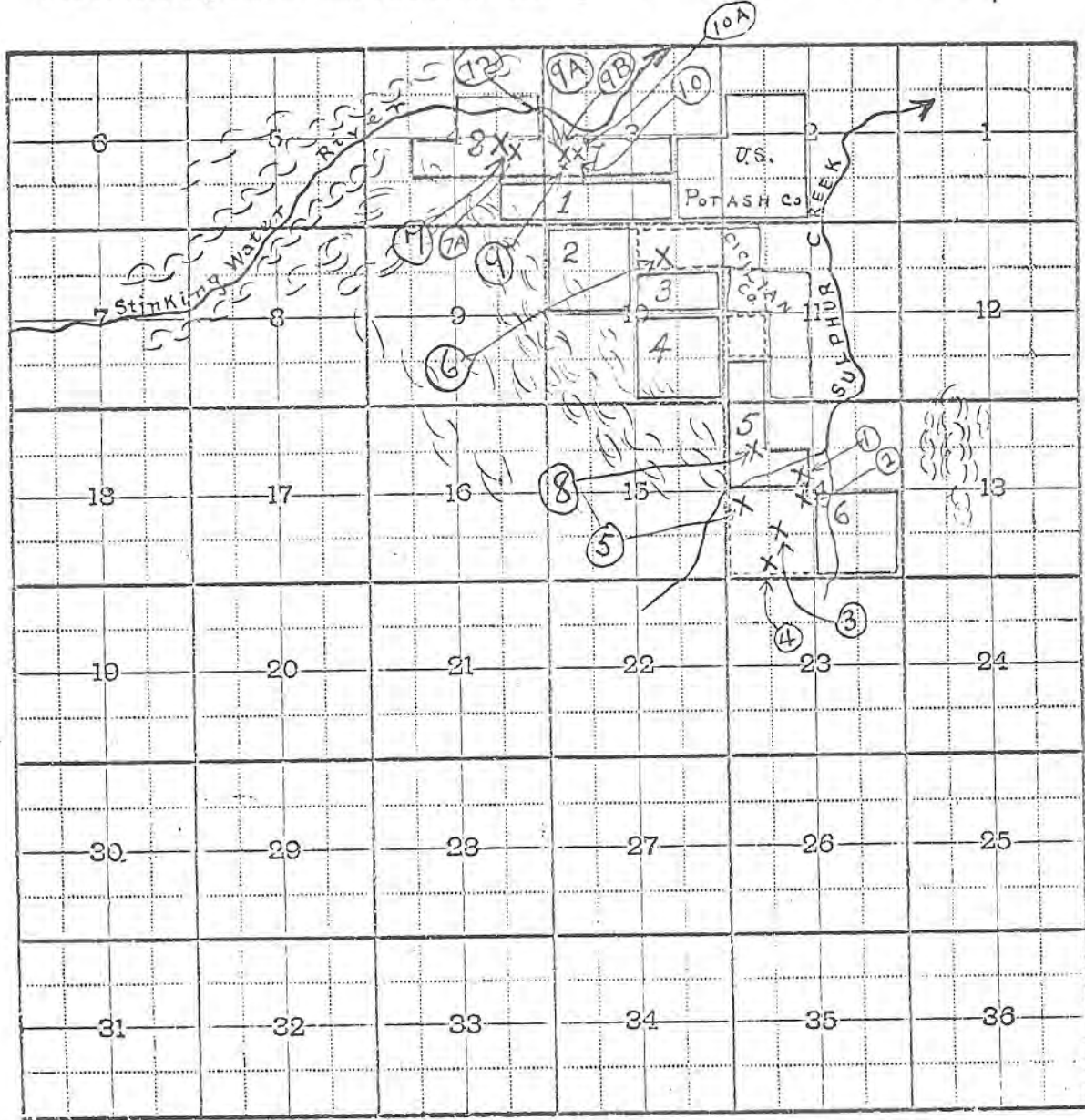


Sulphur Deposits at Cody, Wyo.

3.5	7.5' horizontal exposure here. Open face on hill side about 175 feet South-west of sample #2.
3.2	Location about 250' South sample #3. In extinct geyser - Considerable gypsum mixed with one.
4.0	Named "Sulphure" claim. South-West corner section 14. (?) Open Pit. about 3 feet wide, and 6 feet long.
2.1	Located on N.E. half of N.E. quarter of section 10. - a natural cut or draw. Sulphur with gypsum quartz.
1.8	Upper bench of westerly cut on Beck tract. (Claim No. 8.)
7.0	Lower bench of west cut on Beck tract (Claim No. 8) - Three feet from top, was inaccessible for sampling. (Had no ladder)
Grab Sample	Location on north side Sulphur Creek. An old geyser mound, with much gypsum. (This is within claim # 5.)
4.9	Upper bench of east cut on Beck tract. (Claim No. 7). Mostly appeared to be limestone. Looked poor.
10.5	Lower bench of big cut on Beck claim No. 7.
4.5	Same as above. Sample taken from east wall of cut. (Beck claim No. 7.)
3.8	From small open cut about 75 feet east of above. - Looks very rich in S.
Selected Chunks of Best Ore	Location same as above. almost pure sulphur.
Selected Chunks Ore	Samples of chunks of ore from Big Cut (Beck claim No. 7) Same location as samples 9, 9A, 9B.
