Funk Mica - Sec. 32, T. 13, R. 78.

A pit about 25'-30' long and 8'-10' wide in a microcline, quartz, muscovite pegmatite. About 3'-4' deep. Pit runs S. 55° E.

The dike is principally microcline and quartz; the mica is in small quantities and is at best punch - the rest is scrap. No clevelandite and no beryl or tantalite in the pit or on the dump.

This property seems to be of no value - even by hand picking the mica it would not be profitable (some small amount of picked microcline).

No indication on the surface of better material and none in the pit. No evidence of better material in depth.

S32 T13 R18

C-22-42 A pit about 25'-30' long and 8'-10' wide in a microcline,
quartz, muscovite fragments. About 3'-4' deep.

Pit runs S 45° E.

The dike is principally microcline and quartz,
the mica is in small quantities and is at best
poor - the rest is scrap. No cleveite and
no beryl or tantalite in the pit or on the dump.

The property seems to be of no value - even
by hand picking the mica it would not be
profitable (some small amount of pink microcline).

No indications on the surface of better material
+ none in the pit. No evidence of better material
in depth.
